Force, violence, forcefulness, intensity, depending on the context	شدة	al-shidah	A term used in the Syrian Penal Code, prohibiting its use to extract confessions. The Syrian Government has indicated that the prohibition on <i>al-shidah</i> relates to torture as well.

Sexual jihad	جهاد النكاح	jihad al-nikah	Also known as sexual <i>jihad</i> . This is an alleged practice whereby women sympathizing with jihadist extremism travel to war zones such as Iraq and Syria, and voluntarily offer themselves for marriage to jihadist militants, often repeatedly and in temporary marriages, to help boost the fighters' morale.
	عباية	abaya	A long female garment that covers the entire body with the exception of the face and hands.
	مخابرات	mukhabarat	Syrian Government intelligence agencies.
	شبیح \ شبیحة	shabih (sing.)/ shabiha (pl.)	A colloquial term used to refer to pro- Government militias and loyalists.

Burning with cigarette butts and lighters	الحرق باستخدام أعقاب السجائر والقداحات		A notable torture method whereby a restrained detainee has cigarette butts extinguished on their body or where cigarette lighters are used to burn their hands, feet, ears, and hair. ¹
Dragging	السحل		A notable torture method whereby the detainee is dragged along the ground on one foot or by pulling their hair. ²
Drowning	الغرق		A notable torture method whereby the detainee's head is placed inside a large container/barrel filled with water and held under for one or two minutes. ³
Electrocution	الصعق الكهربائي		A notable torture method whereby the detainee is electrocuted with an electric

Fingernail, toenail removal	إزالة أظافر اليد/أظافر القدم		A notable torture method whereby a detainee's hands or feet are restrained and their fingernails or toenails are pulled out with pliers, forceps, or similar instruments. ⁶
Flying carpet	بساط الريح	bisat al rih/ bassat al-reeh	A notable torture method involving a full body beating whereby the detainee is tied to a wooden board made of two bendable sections, each bent towards or away from the other. ⁷
Foot whipping, bastinado, <i>falanga</i>	فلقة	falaqa/ falanga	A notable torture method whereby the soles of the detainee's feet are raised and beaten while they are lying face down with their hands and feet bound together. ⁸
German chair	الكرسي الألماني		A notable torture method whereby the detainee's hands and feet are bound to a metal chair that has flexible parts. Using the back of the chair, the detainee's spine and neck are stretched beyond capacity causing excruciating pain. This torture method may cause severe spinal damage, paralysis, or death.
Hanging	الشبح	shabeh/ al-shabeh	The <i>shabeh</i> position is a notable torture method whereby a hand and foot bound detainee is suspended from the ceiling by a rope secured with rings. ¹⁰ This is done "with their feet barely touching the floor often for long periods of

Lashed, whipped, flogged	الجلد		A notable torture method whereby the detainee is restrained and whipped. ¹³
Long standing	الوقوف الطويل		Also known as stress position. A notable torture method whereby the detainee is forced to stand still for hours with his hands bound either at the back or front and the feet bound at the ankles. 14
Pouring hot water	سكب المياه الساخنة		A notable torture method whereby the near boiling water is poured or sprayed on different parts of the body causing different degrees of burns while the detainee is suspended from the ceiling. ¹⁵
Tyre, tire	دو لاب	dulab	A notable torture method involving "folding detainees into a car tyre" while being beaten and kicked and unable to move. 17
Welcome party	حفلة الترحيب		An expression used to describe beatings received upon arrival and during processing at a detention facility.
	بالانكو	balanco	A notable torture method whereby the detainee is tied up with a rope at their wrists and suspended from a pulley (<i>balanco</i>). Using the pulley, the rope is then raised until the detainee's toes are just out of reach from the ground at which point the detainee is beaten and kicked. ¹⁸
"Green Brahimi" (beaten with pipe)	الأخضر الإبراهيمي	lakhdar brahimi	A notable torture method involving a beating with a green pipe/hose. This
